Interpretive Tours: TBA

This forty-minute tour takes you along the river valley with a guide offering interpretive information regarding many of the events and history that live in the Oldman river valley. Covering everything from the Last Great Indian Battle, the history of the coal mines, and the CPR High Level Bridge.
